Subject: DEATH OF ABE BABCHICK.

- 1- At about 6-55 AM, September 24, 1941, Abe Babchick, Alias "Jew Murphy" #9214 Avenue B-Brooklyn age 38 years, was found in a **Buick** Sedan, Lic, 4-K- 8263 N.Y. Owned by Theodore Fenner #140 Decatur St, which was parked on Empire Blvd, about 25 feet East of Albany Ave, suffering from Gun Shot wound of left side of neck.
- 2- Body was found by Leon Terck #701 Empire Blvd Apt. 2B.
- 3- Pronounced D.O.A. by Dr. Ritz, Kings County Hospital. Medical Examiner, Ruger, notified.
- 4- Reported by Ptl, Samuel Newman, #17680-71st, Precinct. Det. Edward Mc Gowan. 71st, Sgd, assigned.

TRACTS OF BULLETS ARE AS FOLLOWS:- Bullet wound of entrance, No.1, is upward and to the right, passing into the skull cavity thru the occipital bone, near the posterior portion of the foramen magnum, transversing cerebellum and right cerebral hemisphere and making exit thru the exit wound described on the right side of the skull; angle is 45° .

No.2- Takes a course to the right and upward, the angle being 30° , passing into the skull cavity, just posterior to the distal portion of the petrous bone, and passes thru cerebellum and cerebrum. Bullet found lying free in the posterior fossa, is a .32 calibre jacketed bullet.

ON SECTION: Body section is made from the suprasternal notch to the symphysis pubis. Panniculus over the chest measures 3/4" in thickness, over the abdomen 1 1/2". Sternum is removed.

LUNGS: The left lung lies free, is pinkish-gray in color and well aerated. On section is pale in color. Bronchus is natural. Vessels at ~~the~~ the hilus are normal. No abnormal fluid in either chest cavity.

The right lung lies free. Is similar to the left.

HEART: Lies free. Pericardial sac is natural. Heart weighs 370 grams. Epicardium is pale. Myocardium is pale, of normal thickness. No fibrosis is present. Endocardium and valves appear natural. Circumference of the aorta is 12"; early atherosclerotic plaques present. Coronaries are smooth and patent.

LIVER: Is normal in size, pale chocolate brown in color, smooth and glistening. On section cut surface is pale.

GALL BLADDER: Is natural.

SPLEEN: Is normal in size, pinkish-gray in color. Capsule is wrinkled. Consistency is good. On section is very pale.

STOMACH: Contains a pint of well digested thick fluid food content, in which particles of black skinned vegetable material and small pink particles. Color of content is light pink. Small white droplets are also seen. Mucosa is injected.

Intestines are natural throughout. Appendix is present, is normal.

PROSTATE: Is natural.

PANCREAS: Is pale in color. On section is pale, otherwise normal.

ADRENALS: Are normal.

KIDNEYS: Left kidney is normal in size. On section is pale. Capsule strips with ease, leaving smooth pale surface. Markings are normal. The ureter is natural.

Right kidney is similar to the left.

Urinary bladder is distended.

Brain for alcohol determination.

CAUSE OF DEATH:- Gunshot Wounds of the Head:- Homicidal.

CLOTHES; Deceased was clothed as follows; Reddish-brown coat, smeared with vomitus on the right shoulder and front; labeled "Glen Guard Garment" in neck band, on inside pocket labeled "Abe Stark, Brooklyn". Trousers of same material, with a plastic belt, with white metal buckle attached. Is markedly blood stained in back, seat region. Has zipper front. Cleaner's mark 1707.

Pinkish-tan shirt, with a black and white narrow stripe. Is markedly blood stained in front. Labeled "Linn's, Brooklyn".

Vest of similar material as coat and trousers. Brown fedora hat, labeled "Darby Hats, 1616 Pitkin Avenue, Brooklyn, N.Y.

Sleeveless white ribbed undershirt. Markedly blood stained in back. White shorts, with a narrow white and green stripe. Labeled in front, near top button hole, 95.

Black tie, with light white and tan dots. Stained with blood and vomitus. No label.

Low black shoes, with O'Sullivan's rubber heels. Number on inside of left shoe, 83301; on inside of right shoe, 465. Black socks.


I hereby certify that on the 24th day of September 1941,
