## Heffernan Named An Assistant in City Legal Office

Edward A. Heffernan, formerly chief of investigations under Mayor O'Dwyer when the latter was Kings County District Attorney, and for many years an active figure in Brooklyn veteran circles, has been appointed an assistant corporation counsel at a salary of \$6,000 a year.

Although no formal announcement was made of the appointment, Corporation Counsel John J. Bennett said it became effective June 1. He added:

"I've known Ed Heffernan since we were first able to walk. We went to public school and high school together. I can vouch for his character, standing and ability. I'm proud to have him on my staff."

Last Fall Mr. Heffernan was named, along with Mayor O'Dwyer, in a presentment handed up by a special Kings County grand jury which charged negligence in homicide investigations by the District Attorney's office under Mr. O'Dwyer. The presentment later was dropped.
